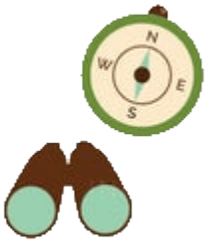

WHO:

Fort Meadow Staff, Students & Families. We are all in this together!

WHAT:

A menu of fun and engaging learning activities that meet the individual needs of the whole child, while capturing the unique learning experiences offered by our preschool team.

WHEN:

March 30th-April 10th Transition Phase: Staff adjusts lessons to provide remote learning experiences
April 13th (and beyond) - Remote learning formally begins

WHERE:

Remote learning takes place in the comfort and safety of your own home

HOW:

Teachers, parents and students will utilize the power of PLAY to provide students with fun and interesting learning challenges, as well as provide regular opportunities for students/families to stay connected with their teachers, peers, and with their learning community. Lessons may be completed through a formal or informal manner, depending on what works best for the unique home-lives of the members of the school community. We want to avoid adding to the anxiety being experienced right now and strive to make life easier for our students, families and staff members during what may be one of the most stressful times in their lives.



Other Important Factors



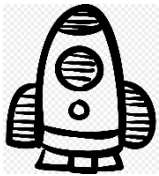
Learning Time

- Learning time will be significantly reduced by at least half of the preschool day



Student Needs

- Whenever possible, the individual needs of children/families will be considered by teachers and specialists.



Assignments

- Teachers will email/post weekly assignments for families to complete with their child(ren), using a flexible schedule that works best for each individual family.

Enrichment

Communication

- Teachers will be available to communicate with students/families during regular school day hours

PLAY

- Play games, play outside, play pretend, just play!



TALK

- Talk about the day, talk about your family stories, talk about the cooking you're doing, talk about future plans.



CREATE

- Create art, create science experiments, create goofy games, create amazing LEGO structures, create memories.



READ

- Read picture books, read chapter books, read magazines, read comic books, read stories you write together.



SING

- Sing favorite songs, sing while washing your hands, sing while having a dance party, sing your own made up songs.
